Minutes of the Zoom Coordination Meeting

Objectives: Discussion of the project implementation, equipment

procurement, planning of Summer Schools 2020.

Considered questions:

During the meeting, the participants discussed the changes in the project implementation, which are related to the logistic and travel situation in the world due to the announcement of quarantine, associated with the spread of the virus COVID-19. The discussion specifically addressed two issues – the procedure of the equipment procurement and conducting of the International BA/MSc Summer Schools 2020.

Decisions:

Based on the opinions and suggestions of the participants of the project, the following decisions have been made:

- 1. Since the previous contract with the equipment supplier has lost its force (the supplier was not able to fulfil the terms of the contract), it was decided to process a new tender procedure:
 - Prepare and send the equipment list for the initial purchase to each target university. Responsible P2 and P5. Deadline 03.04.2020;
 - Each target university must approve the received list of equipment and send it to P2 and P5 until 10.04.2020.

2. Due to the risk of prolonging quarantine in the world, it was decided to postpone the holding of the Summer School in Prague, the Czech Republic, which was originally planned for July 2020. Possible Summer School in Prague rescheduling dates – January, February, or July 2021. Holding the Summer School September 2020 in Plovdiv, Bulgaria remains unchanged.
